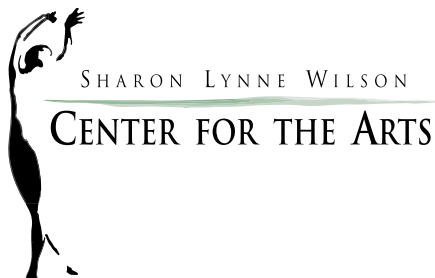

A Message from Jonathan Winkle, Executive Director Mary Strohmaier, Board President

We are pleased to share this 2007–08 Annual Report of the Sharon Lynne Wilson Center for the Arts as we celebrate yet another successful season of shows, special events, classes, and educational activities. This was a year of incredible challenge and change for the Center that has left us energized and renewed.

New leadership, both in our professional staff and in our volunteer ranks, has brought new ideas to make the Center even better. Last August, when our Executive Director departed for the much-larger Milwaukee Ballet, volunteers and staff stepped up their investment of time and energy. Within a few months, we found Jonathan Winkle, our new Executive Director. As former head of the Knoxville Symphony and past Vice President of Community Engagement at the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, Jonathan has vast experience in arts education, fund development, performance programming, and industry sales. He is ideally suited to the Center. In addition, we were able to fill staff openings in operations, marketing, and development with experienced professionals.

The 2007–08 season showcased spectacular talent at the Center. Last fall, Broadway leading man, Brian Stokes Mitchell, brought down the house with his enormous vocal and emotional range, singing

such standards as *The Impossible Dream* from *Man from La Mancha*. David Hazeltine, Milwaukee-native turned New York City piano man, transformed the Dawes Studio Theater into a night club in Midtown, playing sophisticated riffs from original jazz compositions. Heating us up during the worst winter in many a year were Tony DeSare—a young Sinatra in the making—and jazz violin great, Regina Carter, who recounted moving stories of her life through a concert dedicated to her late mother. Who could forget the nine men forming the a capella vocal ensemble Cantus? What an extraordinary performance that was! In addition, Cantus spent the day with over 150 boys from the School District of Elmbrook, providing vocal coaching. And, the last concert of the season was truly a glimpse into young artistic greatness with concert pianist, Jonathan Biss. Horowitz and Rubenstein, move over!

Our Arts Education program continues to evolve. The *Beyond the Classroom* series, which supports classroom initiatives, had 4,700 students and teachers from Milwaukee and Waukesha counties participate this year. Professional performers from our performing series, such as American Repertory Ballet, Mendelssohn String Quartet, and Cantus worked with students and adults for residences and master classes. We continue our mutually beneficial cooperation with the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music, First Stage Theater Academy and—more recently—Danceworks, the Milwaukee-based dance group that will help us greatly expand our ability to reach diverse audiences and interests in a broad array of classes. Check our web site (wilson-center.com) and our various publications for details.

A huge accomplishment this past year was the successful completion of a capital campaign that will go a long way toward retiring our construction mortgage. In response to a generous challenge grant of \$500,000 from our friends Don and Kate Wilson, we raised an additional \$500,000 from individuals, corporations, and foundations who understand how important the arts are in people's lives.

All of the above could not have been accomplished without our many volunteers and supporters. We would be remiss in not thanking all of you who support the Center through your BackStage memberships, ticket purchases, and sponsorships of shows and events, as well as our dedicated volunteers who donate thousands of hours of time planning and organizing our four fundraisers and working events such as the Hidden River Art Festival.

Without you, there simply would be no Wilson Center.

Performing Arts

The Wilson Center once again presented over 50 performances of nationally and regionally recognized artists from a variety of artistic disciplines and genres. By featuring dance companies such as American Repertory Ballet and Complexions, our regional community was exposed to choreography and dancing quality typically accessible only in the largest cities.

The sheer beauty and variety of sound capable of being produced by the human voice was also very much in evidence. Monica Mancini showcased not only her father's extraordinary work, but her own prodigious talent as a singer. Brian Stokes Mitchell left no doubt with a cheering crowd as to why he is truly Broadway's leading man. New York Voices and Cantus, two vocal ensembles, performed amazing arrangements of jazz standards, powerfully moving spirituals, and other contemporary songs that left us all in disbelief and wonderment. These ensembles also gave generously of their time and talent by participating in engaging artist dialogues and master classes throughout the year.

Instrumental musicians do not have the benefit of words to communicate their artistry. Jazz violinist, Regina Carter and pianist, Jonathan Biss are those rare musicians whose playing transcends text, in fact, their music is ineffable.

And, for outdoor concert fans, the eight Starry Nights concerts were a popular hit with such acts as Streetlife with Warren Wiegratz, Nabori and the Nob Hill Boys.

For the over 20,000 people who attended our concerts and other performances, we hope we changed your life in some positive way, even if for only two hours at a time.



Visual Arts

Hidden River Art Festival

The second Hidden River Art Festival was held September 21–23, 2007, and drew 4,158 paid attendees on a picture-perfect fall weekend. This event admits only 80 Wisconsin fine artists, and is a very visible extension of the work in the Ploch Art Gallery. Both artists and art patrons tell us that the Festival is quickly becoming a spotlight event in the upper Midwest, helping to achieve our vision of a unique “gallery” festival.

Ploch Art Gallery

The Ploch Art Gallery featured the work of five outstanding Wisconsin artists who had previously been recognized in juried competition by the Wisconsin Academy of Sciences, Arts and Letters. The season was sponsored by Marjorie A. and Raymond G. Vallier, with contributing sponsorship from The Equitable Bank.

Arts Education and Community

Professional Artists

The Wilson Center continues to seek opportunities for visiting performers to work in residencies and master classes with students in the local community and even beyond to Milwaukee and southeastern Wisconsin. Opportunities this year included outreach with the American Repertory Ballet, and master classes with jazz musician David Hazeltine, Complexions Contemporary Ballet, and the Mendelssohn String Quartet, reaching nearly 100 youth and adults. One of our most fulfilling outreach efforts came in May when Cantus, an all-male a cappella ensemble, worked with 150 area middle school boys in a day-long program of vocal coaching, sectionals, discussion, and mini-performance.

Lectures and Discussions

In addition to hands-on learning, the Center regularly offers opportunity to dialogue with artists and scholars, providing insight to performance and visual arts activity. Highlights from this year included visits from curators at the Milwaukee Art Museum, UWM dance educators Elizabeth Johnson and Luc Vanier discussing ballet's glass ceiling, and an exploration of the songs of Shakespeare with Milwaukee Shakespeare's Marcella Kearns and the Florentine Opera's Corliss Phillabaum.

Classes and Workshops

Stronger integration of our visual art exhibitions with the Wilson Center's educational programs is a priority going forward. Several workshops and activities were offered in conjunction with Ploch Gallery artists and Hidden River Festival artists. Highlights included a studio visit and exhibit tour in Sheboygan with artist Amy Ruffo, and a youth art workshop with artist Jeremy Wolf. Additional visual arts activities attracted over 160 adults and children.

The Center was proud to continue our association with the Milwaukee Ballet, First Stage Theater Academy, and Wisconsin Conservatory of Music in providing high-quality dance, theater, and music opportunities to the broader community.

Additionally, collaborative camps were held in conjunction with First Stage Theater Academy, Milwaukee Art Museum, Milwaukee Ballet School, and Wisconsin Conservatory of Music: the annual **Arts Camp** was sold out with 66 students in June (June 23–27, 2008, for grades 1–6), and a new **October Art Break** took advantage of a school-release day on Thursday, October 25, for 20 children in grades 1–5.



Volunteers and Interns

Volunteers play an essential role in the Center's operation. More than 250 volunteers from our community serve the Wilson Center as board members, committee members, ushers, docents, office help, and general help with artists and grounds crew for the Hidden River Art Festival.

As an example of the dedication of Wilson Center volunteers, over 80 people donated their time in 2007-08 to sit on special event committees resulting in nearly \$314,000 being raised to support the Center's programming across four special events (see page 8).

Additionally, 130 volunteers donated 7,910 hours as ushers for performances and at Hidden River. At minimum wage, these volunteer contributions exceeded \$51,000 in value to the Wilson Center's 2007-08 season!

Administrative interns are vital to the smooth running of behind-the-scenes office work, and allow college students an opportunity to get hands-on experience in a professional arts organization. Several interns assisted in a variety of projects and departments throughout the year, supporting the full-time staff with the Fashion Show, Hidden River Art Festival, Winter Soiree, Arts Camp, and more.

We genuinely appreciate the hard work and dedication of our volunteer staff.

Beyond the Classroom

A key component of our curriculum-based programming is the *Beyond the Classroom* series, which regularly fills the auditorium with school groups for performances that support classroom initiatives. This year we continued to develop stronger study materials for educators, connecting directly to the Wisconsin Model Academic Standards. With this programming, we have reached well over 15,000 students in the short six years since opening the doors. Continuing a holiday tradition for the sixth year, the annual Holiday Arts Festival (November 18, 2007) was a festive celebration of some of the arts organizations with whom we work so closely. Two performances of excerpts from *The Nutcracker*, performed by Milwaukee Ballet II and Milwaukee Ballet School, were supplemented by photograph opportunities with the dancers, costume display, holiday selections from the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music, and art projects with the Milwaukee Art Museum staff for 680 guests.

Special Events

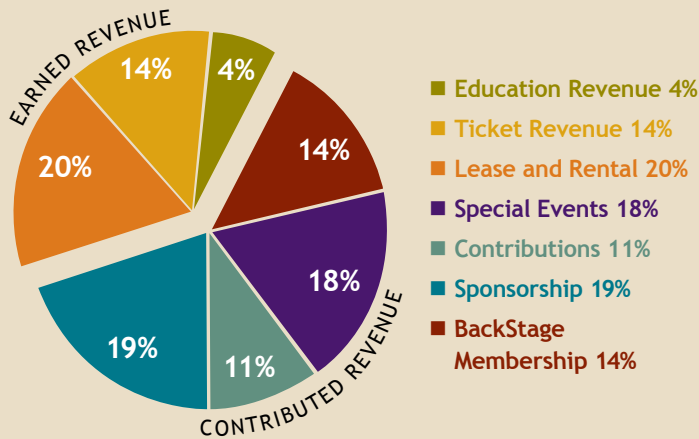

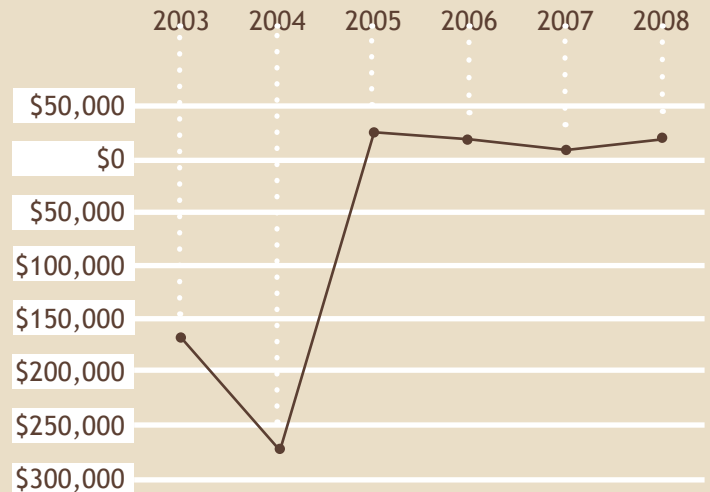

Financial Narrative

The Wilson Center has again achieved its goal of positive net operating income for the 2007-08 fiscal year.

Through the generous support of its patrons, sponsors, members, and contributors, the Center grew operating income by 4%, on track with the growth in operating expenses.

As indicated in the revenue pie chart, the Center's income is derived from a number of sources with no single source accounting for a significant part of total revenue.

Since opening in 2002, the Center has reduced its outstanding debt from an original amount of \$9.5 million to the current balance of less than \$2.0 million. This has been accomplished through successful fundraising efforts including a \$1.0 million campaign effort during the past year. Current capital pledges will pay off a significant portion of the remaining debt over the next several years.

Earnings from the Center's recently established endowment fund are expected to contribute to operating revenue in the future. The fund is managed by a committee separate from the Board of Directors and the management of the Center.

Community Events

Throughout the year, many corporations, organizations, community schools, and individuals use a variety of spaces at the Wilson Center. Its lodge-in-the-park design places guests in a natural, comfortable setting that is enhanced by technological amenities, sublime acoustics, and integrated art. The wide-ranging use of the facility fulfills the vision of the Wilson Center founders—a spectacular setting for a myriad of community events.
