Nature-themed Arts Camp offered at the Wilson Center this June

"Our arts campers will have an incredible time exploring the fields, woods, and riverbanks around the Wilson Center," notes Laura Aaron Sear, the Center's education director. "Bugs, animals, vegetation—we'll be creating artworks, movement, and sounds in response to all of these inspirations."

Day camp activities take place both indoors and outdoors each day. An optional fifth day of fun classes can be added to round out the week. The Wilson Center also offers before- and after-care options, too.

The Sharon Lynne Wilson Center for the Arts is a non-profit, multi-disciplinary cultural arts center that offers performances by regional and touring groups, and arts education. Wisconsin artists are showcased at the Hidden River Art Festival in September and in the Ploch Art Gallery with five exhibitions each year.
